- Turn left onto 60th Street and follow for 0.3 miles. It will be on the left side of street.

- Merge onto WA 512 E towards Puyallup
- Merge onto WA 167 N towards Seattle
- Merge onto WA 410 E towards Sumner/Yakima
- Take 166th Ave E. exit and turn left onto 166 Ave E. and follow for 0.2 miles. 166th Ave E. becomes Sumner/Lake Tapps Highway.
