

Generators

Electricity will not be available, however generators are allowed in the food court. Due to the limited space the noise can be a nuisance. We try to keep the generators at one end of the food court so that the noise is contained in a single area. In order to help with this please indicate whether you have a QUIET generator or not on your application.

Sanitation

It is the responsibility of each vendor to keep a clean and sanitary area. Water may be obtained from a central water valve and kept in your own buckets. **Each vendor is required to furnish trash cans at their booth.** Trash, wastewater and grease must be contained and disposed of properly. Cold foods must be kept in clean coolers and kept iced. Hot foods must be kept at their proper temperatures. All food vendors are required to wear hair restraints, hats or hairnets, latex gloves and follow health rules

Applications

Signed rules and applications are due no later than **June 1st, 2012.**

Foods

The Jefferson County Watermelon Festival is a large event that brings in about 10,000 people each year. To try and satisfy the public as well as our vendors we like to provide a variety of foods so that the public has a variety of choices and so each vendor makes a fair profit. **IN ORDER TO HELP US AND TO HELP YOURSELF, PLEASE INDICATE ON THE APPLICATION ALL FOOD ITEMS THAT YOU WILL BE SELLING. ALL FOODS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE. VENDORS MUST NOT SELL ITEMS NOT APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE. THOSE WHO DO WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.**

FOOD VENDOR INFORMATION

Booth spaces will be selected on a "first come first serve" basis by category of food being presented.

Mobile Units

Tents, Tables, Mobile Food Trailers or Pushcarts are allowed. Any and all mobile units should cover an area no larger than **12' x 15'**.

IF MORE SPACE IS NEEDED VENDORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR ADDITIONAL SPACES.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Units **MUST** be able to be made stationary.

SET UP

NO SET UPS BEFORE NOON

Vendors may set up and begin operating Friday at 1:00 PM.

Vendors must be set up Saturday prior to 8:00 AM. (Streets will be closed by 8:00 AM for the event)

All vendors areas will be checked before 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and breakdowns can begin after they have been checked!

ALL ACCEPTED APPLICANTS OWNING MOBILE FOOD TRAILERS MUST LET THE FOOD COMMITTEE KNOW THE SIZE OF THEIR UNITS IN ORDER TO BE PROPERLY PLACED.

FEES

Fee is \$65.00 per space. Booth space is 12' x 15'. **IF MORE ROOM IS NEEDED ADDITIONAL SPACES MUST BE PURCHASED.**
