There will be a lecture at the trailhead to enhance environmental and cultural awareness as participants embrace nature retracing prehistoric steps on this authentic adventure. SEARCH FOR THE WACISSA VOLCANO TOUR

FEBRUARY 11, 12, 18, 19, 25, & 26

Participants will explore the third largest contiguous land area in Florida along the Wacissa River, virtually unchanged since the Paleo Indians inhabited these lands and waters 14,000 years ago. In this wild landscape of Southern Jefferson County, known as the Flatwoods, participants will search for the ancient volcano, active in the 20th century. This tour, approximately 4 hours in duration, is designed for the moderately experienced hiker, one used to uneven terrain and in generally good health. Participants will be led by a highly skilled outdoorsman with a lecture at the trailhead. Included in the price is a delicious box lunch and beverages. The cost per person is \$65.00.
