### Leash-free canine recreation time in the indoor arenas.

Dog owners now have access to an indoor off-leash park to exercise and socialize with their animal. The indoor arenas provide a wonderful place for your dogs to play during the winter months.

The facility offers:

- a safe, fenced environment for your dogs to play and socialize
- plenty of seating available and washrooms in the lobby
- double gated entrances
- separate small/large dog areas, permitting small, puppies in training, elderly or timid dogs to take part
- water is available for your dogs

**Cost:** \$2.00 per dog per session (includes GST).



### Rules

- USE AT YOUR OWN RISK
- The Municipality of Central Huron and the Regional Equine & Agricultural Centre of Huron assume no responsibility for any injuries or damage that might occur during use of this area.
- Open from 3:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Sundays
- Up to date rabies, vaccinations and licence tags required
- Leash your dog while entering and exiting the exercise area
- Keep your dog within sight and under verbal control. Dogs must be under control and in sight of their handler at all times.
- All dog waste must be picked up and disposed of in the appropriate containers supplied.
- No puppies under 4 months, female dogs in heat, sick dogs or aggressive dogs
- Dogs required by law to be leashed and muzzled must remain so while in the off-leash arena
- Dogs with muzzles are acceptable.
- No glass containers, food or toys. No food (people or dog) is permitted in the arena area. Small, bite-sized training treats are acceptable, but food in bowls and long-lasting chews are not allowed. Human food is permitted in the seating areas.
- Children must be supervised by an adult
- Parents are advised this site is not suitable for young children
- Off-leash area users are subject to the Dog Owners' Liability Act. Under the Dog Owner's Liability Act, you are responsible for your dog and any damage it inflicts on another dog or person.
