Registry Definitions:

A Register – Purebred American Saddlebreds that are eligible for the Stud Book and have met all DNA requirements.

AA Register – Purebred American Saddlebreds that at the time of Application, have not met all DNA requirements for the Stud Book

B Register – Partbred American Saddlebreds with at least 50% American Saddlebred breeding

S Register – Sporthorses with at least 25% American Saddlebred breeding, no DNA requirement (non breeding Register)

GG Register – Georgian Grandes that meet International Georgian Grande criteria

This is a brief summary to help you choose the correct Register for your American Saddlebred or Georgian Grande horse. For the full definitions, please refer to our Code of Conduct. Criteria to meet Georgian Grande requirements are available on the Saddlebred Australia website www.saddlebredaustralia.org.au. If in doubt, please contact the Secretary.
