



Lesson and Facility Rules



- ◇ **Safety and etiquette must be practiced at all times.**
- ◇ **No smoking at any facility leased by instructor.**
- ◇ **No alcohol permitted at any facility leased by instructor and absolutely no handling of horses by intoxicated persons.**
- ◇ **No dogs may be brought to any facility leased by instructor.**
- ◇ **No unregistered spectators or visitors permitted at any facility leased by instructor.**
- ◇ **No spectators or visitors under 13 years of age permitted at any facility leased by instructor. PERIOD.**
- ◇ **No handling of any horses or equipment other than your own without specific permission from instructor.**
- ◇ **Lesson and Facility Rules and Release of Liability must be signed by all students and spectators.**
- ◇ **Close and latch any and all gates you open (and please close and latch any that you find were left open) at any facility leased by instructor.**
- ◇ **Boots or shoes with heels are required for riders.**
- ◇ **ASTM/SEI approved helmets required for all riders 18 years old and under.**
- ◇ **ASTM/SEI approved helmets required for all riders riding above a trot.**
- ◇ **Please notify instructor, owner or manager of facility of anything you consider to be a problem or a potential problem.**
- ◇ **Try to have some fun!**

Release of Liability



In consideration received, and in return for the use, today and on all future dates of the property, facilities and services of Karen Yeager, hereinafter called "Instructor" and Lone Star Ranch, LLC, hereinafter called "Ranch", the undersigned, hereinafter called "Student", student's heirs, assigns and representatives hereby agree as follows:

1. Student has been provided with a copy of the Instructor's Lesson and Facility Rules and agrees to comply with all of them.

2. In the event Student is using Student's own horse, or a horse(s) not owned by Instructor or Ranch, Student warrants said horse(s) shall be free from infection, contagious or transmittable diseases. Instructor and Ranch reserve the right to refuse access or use of any horse upon the premises that does not appear to Instructor and Ranch to be in good health, or is deemed dangerous or undesirable.

3. Inherent Risks and Assumption of Risk. Student acknowledges there are inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below, and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in ways such as: running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

Student acknowledges that horses by their very nature are unpredictable and subject to animal whim, which may include behavior including but not limited to their propensity to kick, bite, shy, buck, stumble, bolt, rear or general unpredictability. Student assumes all risks in connection therewith, and expressly waives any claims for any injury or loss arising therefrom. Student agrees to abide by and follow Instructor's and Ranch's rules and regulations, which shall be posted and/or available from time to time. Student further acknowledges that the behavior of any animal is contingent to some extent upon the ability of Student. Student assumes all risks therefore and warrants a full and fair disclosure of Student's abilities has been made to Instructor.

STUDENT (OR STUDENT'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN) AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND INSTRUCTOR AND RANCH AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTION, DAMAGES, JUDGMENTS, ORDERS, COSTS OR EXPENSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEY'S FEES, WHICH MAY IN ANY WAY ARISE FROM OR BE IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH STUDENT'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON THE PROPERTY OF INSTRUCTOR AND RANCH AND THE FACILITIES LOCATED THEREON. In the event student is a minor, the parent, legal guardian or authorized adult shall further indemnify, defend and hold Instructor and Ranch harmless from any such claims by said minor child, regardless of any statute of limitations or contractual limitation of actions.
