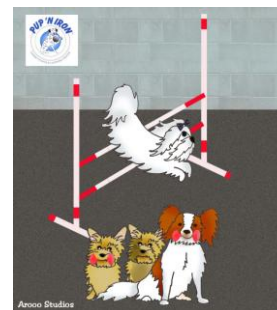

## Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is of primary importance. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- **THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND** for no shows or entries withdrawn **after the closing date** or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be made for bitches in season if request is accompanied by a veterinarian's certification.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks.**
- **Confirmations** - Entry confirmations will be emailed to valid email address shortly after the trial closing date. If you wish to confirm receipt of you entry prior to the closing date, please enclose a self-address postage paid postcard or envelope.
- **Waiting List** - If we fill before the closing date, we will maintain a waiting list to fill any cancellations.
- **Awards** - Rosettes will be awarded for High in Trial, High Combined, and High Scoring Junior Handler. Placement rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place qualifying dogs in each class in each trial. All qualifying scores will receive qualifying ribbons.
- All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to still photos or video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All still photos, video, broadcast, and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the UKC or the trial host(s).
- Dogs must remain under control at all times whether on or off leash while on show grounds. Crates or any property left overnight are done so at your own risk.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area. Handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial judges and/or trial officials, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Please be considerate of others and **clean up after your dog** at the trial site and motel facilities. **Owners/handlers not cleaning up after their dogs are subject to dismissal from the trial without refund.**
- **Judges will not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class.**
- Incorrect / incomplete entries, late entries or entries received without the appropriate fees will not be accepted. They will be returned to the sender via U.S. Mail. (Minor questions may be handled by telephone if the entrant has indicated on the entry form that he/she will accept collect calls or by email if the entrant provides an address.)
- After the trial closes, no refunds will be given except for bitches in season. In this case, a Veterinarian's certificate will be required and a \$5.00 handling fee will be assessed.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed on the premises on Saturday and Sunday, March 6 & 7, 2010.

## Directions to Trial Site:

### From Points North:

Take I-95 South to Exit 140 -Stafford Rt. 630. Make a left from exit ramp and go East on Rt. 630 (Courthouse Rd.) to the first traffic light. Turn right onto Rt. 1 South (Jefferson Davis Highway) and proceed 3.4 miles to Perchwood Drive. Turn left onto Perchwood Drive (Across from the Sports Booth) and make immediate left into first driveway. (United Transmission -mustard yellow building -will be on your right.) Follow that driveway all the way to the back to the cobble stone front building (21 Perchwood Drive). Pup `N Iron is Unit 111, located directly behind the gas station.

### From Points South:

Take I-95 North to Exit 136-Stafford Airport/Centerport Pkwy. Follow the exit to the first stop sign. Make a right, following the signs for Route 1. At Rt. 1 make another right and go North. Proceed about 2 miles and make a right onto Perchwood Drive (Across from The Sports Booth) Go to first driveway on the left and turn left. United Transmission (mustard yellow building) will be on your right. Pull all the way back to the parking lot in front of a set of stone front buildings. We are at 21 Perchwood Drive, Unit 111, directly behind the Chevron gas station.

## About the Trial

On Saturday & Sunday, March 6 & 7, 2010, the Pup `N Iron Toy Dog Sports & Performance Club will hold 4 agility trials under the regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. These off-lead trials are open to all UKC registered dogs that are 12 months of age or older. Agility I, II and III titling classes will be offered. Entry in the Agility II class is open to dogs with or without the Agility I title. A dog may be entered in the Agility I and Agility II classes at the same trial. Entry in the Agility III Class is open only to those dogs that have completed the requirements for the United Agility Champion title (UACH).

The Agility I and Agility II classes will be split into two sections, A and B. The Agility I-A class (AGI-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGI title. The Agility I-B class (AGI-B) will be open to all dogs. Agility II-A class (AGII-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGII title. The Agility II-B class (AGII-B) will be open to all dogs. All points toward the United Agility Champion title (UACH) must be earned from the Agility I-B and the Agility II-B classes. All points towards United Grand Agility Champion (UGRACH) must be earned from Agility I-B, Agility II-B, and Agility III classes.

When a dog in AG I B has not earned an AG I title or a dog in AG II B has not earned an AG II title; they shall be permitted a course familiarization in that class, notwithstanding that the handler would be ineligible to enter the respective AG IA or the AG II A class.

Equipment will be provided courtesy of the Mattaponi Agility Dogs. The trials will be held indoors on rubber matting. All dogs must be on lead or crated except when exhibiting in the ring.

## To Enter

Send a completed copy of the UKC entry form (or copy thereof), and a check or money order. Entries close at 6:00pm on Monday, February 22, 2010. The entry fee is \$14.00 per entry. This trial is pre-entry only; **no entries will be accepted at the show site.**

Specify on your entry whether you are ending Section A or B.

- Use one entry form per dog.
- You **MUST** provide either a UKC registration number or temporary number. Otherwise the entry will be rejected. (Note: you can obtain a temporary number over the phone (616-343-9020) or on the web at [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com). Points earned will be credited if a full registration is completed within 60 days of the points being earned.)
- Include an email address or an authorization to call collect. Otherwise, problems with the entry will be handled by postal mail.

## Jump Height Divisions

We assign divisions by the height of the dog. If you indicate on the entry form that the height of the dog is 14 inches, it will be placed in division one. If you indicate that the height of the dog is 14.25, it would be put in division two. The same goes if you put down 20 inches for the dog's height; it will be put into division two unless you specify a height greater than 20 inches. **No dog may jump higher than its assigned jump height.**

- Be sure to indicate the correct division for your dog:

Division I	Height at withers up to and <b>including</b> 14"
Division II	Greater than 14" up to and <b>including</b> 20"
Division III	Greater than 20"

- Course Builder:** Assists the Chief Course Builder with placing obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge.
- Ring Steward:** Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens the chutes.
- Gate Steward:** Checks off and calls exhibitors to the gate, in the correct order and ready to run.
- Leash Runner:** Takes the exhibitor's leash from the start line and places it at finish line.
- Timer:** Times the dog's run using a stopwatch.
- Sheet Runner:** Takes scribe sheet from the Judge and gives it to the Score Table.
- Sunday Night Tear Down:** Dismantling equipment.
