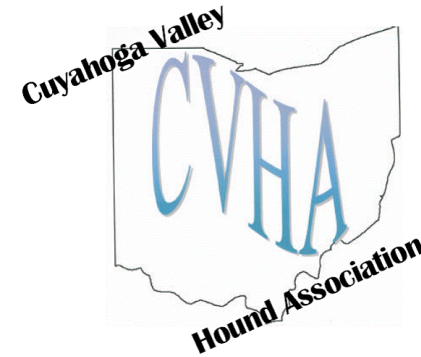

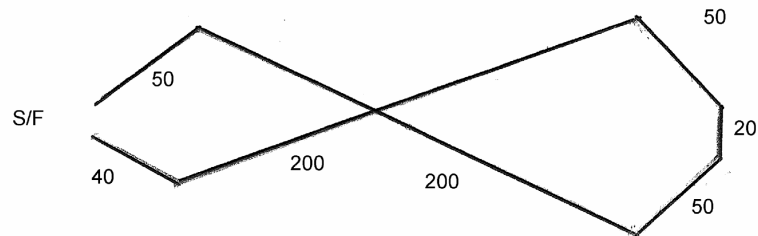

ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Rhodesian Ridgebacks, that are one year of age or older on the day of the tests and have been registered with The American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) may be entered. Breed disqualifications apply.

TESTS OFFERED

Junior Courser (JC): Open to Rhodesian Ridgebacks. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge at one test, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later test, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The JC is no longer required AT ALL to enter the open stake but is still available as a suffix title for those wishing to attain it.

Qualifying Courser (QC): Open to Rhodesian Ridgebacks, The qualifying hound will run with another hound, completing a minimum 600 yard course with a minimum of 5 turns.

The qualifying hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm, without interruption, and without coursing, interfering with, or aggressing on, the other hound. Owner of qualifying hound must provide or arrange for a hound of like running style for their hound to run with in this test.

Notes regarding the new QC tests: All dogs starting out in lure coursing and wanting to enter the Open Stake must now earn a Qualifying Courser certificate. (Unless said hound has run in the open or open veteran stake in a trial prior to Jan. 1, 2010, or holds a field champion title from ASFA or CKC – a copy of such title now needs to accompany the hound's first AKC trial entry). You will be handed the certification form at roll call. You must fill out your part and have the judge sign and date it if your dog qualifies. Keep this form as it will need to be attached to your hound's first entry in the open stake.

- ** A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose hound on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- ** Battery powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic.
- ** Back-up equipment will be available.
- ** CVHA reserves the right to alter course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial.
- ** Adequate shade and cool/drinking water should be provided by the participants.
- ** Bitches in season or lame hounds will be excused and entry fees refunded.
- ** Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee. Children **MUST** be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judges and handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.

These events are being held in conjunction with The Ridgeback Rodeo. ASFA certifications will be offered on all days of the Rodeo, except during AKC test hours. Judge for ASFA Certifications will be Paul Kytta II.

Directions:

We are located in northwestern PA about 2 1/2 miles from the Ohio line and about 30 miles south of Erie, PA.

From Ohio and the Cleveland area west of us: Take I90 east and exit at Rt. 84/Rt. 193 (Kingsville, Ohio). Go straight across intersection at Rt. 193 at end of exit ramp and you will be on Rt. 84 east. Take 84 east about 5 miles to Rt. 7 (blinking light). Turn right or south on Rt. 7 and drive 6.7 miles to Rt. 167 east. Take 167 east 5.2 miles into PA to Beaver Center Road (no road sign or stop sign, white ranch with blue shutters on northwest corner, Rt. 167 turns into Rt. 198 at the PA line). Turn right or south on Beaver Center Road. We are the second farm on the left 1/2 mile south of Rt. 198.

From the Pittsburg area south of us: Take I79 north to Saegertown exit Rt. 198 west. Follow 198 west signs about 15 miles(?) through some small towns to Conneautville. At Samuels Grocery store in Conneautville turn left, go over railroad tracks and immediately veer right onto 198 west again. Beaver Center Road is about 5 miles west of town. Turn left, second farm on left 1/2 mile south of Rt. 198.

From Canfield/Youngstown, OH area south of us: Take Rt. 11 north to Rt. 167 exit. Turn right or east on Rt. 167 and go about 7 miles to Rt. 7 in Pierpont. (You will pass Rt. 193). Turn left on Rt. 7 and go 1 mile to Rt. 167 east again and turn right. Drive 5.2 miles (you will cross into PA and road turns into Rt. 198) to Beaver Center Rd. and turn right. We are 2nd farm on left 1/2 mile south of Rt. 198.

From upstate NY: Take I90 west and exit at Rt. 6, West Springfield, PA. Turn south or left on Rt. 6. Drive a short distance, go under underpass and watch for Griffy Road which is the second road on the right. It is easy to miss. Turn right and stay on this road for about 12(?) miles. Griffy Road turns into S. Beaver Road. As soon as you cross Rt. 198 (there is a stop sign here), we are 2nd farm on the left, 1/2 mile south of Rt. 198.
