For Showing, Obedience, Retrieving, Tracking and Agility/Jumping

General Conditions:

1. Applicants must be financial members of the Weimaraner Club of S.A. Inc, at the time of gaining points. Our Constitution states that members cease to be financial if their subscriptions are not paid within 21 days after the Annual General Meeting. If applicants have not renewed their subscriptions by that time, points may only be accumulated from the date of payment.
2. All applicants must be financial members of the S.A.C.A. Inc., or the controlling body in their home state.
3. Points for these awards are granted only for competitions held within the Club financial year Oct 1st to Sept 30th)
4. Points may only be gained from competitions held in South Australia under the auspices of the S.A.C.A. Inc.
5. Members must apply to the Trophy Officer for recognition of points scored no later than **Friday 12/10/07. NO LATE ENTRIES** will be accepted. Applications must be accompanied by copies of the appropriate documentation, i.e. Challenge or reserve certificates, obedience place and /or score cards and retrieving place cards.

THE PERPETUAL TROPHIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Showing - The "Aust Ch Rosengarten Shazzan (N) CD CDX ET QC Memorial Trophy"

Presented to the highest Challenge Point Scoring Weimaraner at Challenge Certificate level (i.e. no extra points for Best In Group or Best in Show, except at the Weimaraner Club of SA Inc. Championship Show where Best In Show will gain 25 points). Since the separation of the breed this Trophy is only available to Weimaraners.

General Conditions:

1. Applications must be financial members of the Weimaraner Club of SA Inc. If annual subscriptions are unpaid by- 31st January.. points may only be scored from the date of payment.
2. All applicants must be financial members of the SACA Inc or the controlling body.
3. Points for annual awards are granted for competitions held within the Club Financial Year (Oct 1st to Sept 30th)
4. Points may only be gained from competitions held in South Australia.
5. Dogs must have points from at least TWO of the following- Field Trials, Retrieving Trials, Championship Shows, Obedience Trials, Tracking Trials or Agility Trials.

Members must apply for recognition of points scored no later than Friday 12th October 2007. No late entries will be accepted.

SHOW DOG OF THE YEAR & SHOW BITCH OF THE YEAR (WEIMARANER & WEIMARANER LONG HAIR)

General Conditions: Only those dogs owned by financial members of the Weimaraner Club of SA Inc would be eligible to compete for these trophies. Interstate members are eligible to compete in this competition. Should a lapse of membership occur, any points gained during that lapse in membership will be ineligible for inclusion in the Club competition. In the case of a dog/bitch being in joint ownership, all partners must be financial members of the Weimaraner Club of SA Inc..

The onus is on the owner of the dog/bitch to submit up to their 8 best scores.

In the event of a tied score, a count back system will be used to determine the result. Points will only be counted from the nominated point score shows selected at the AGM and listed in the newsletter. **Attendance at a minimum of 6 shows is required for all Pointscore Trophies . If no CC or Res CC certificate won, competitor must send in a photocopy of the page from catalogue as proof of attendance.**

Rationale: These trophies were introduced by the club to encourage maximum participation at the nominated Point Score shows.

Method of Scoring: Challenge = 10 points Reserve Challenge = 4 points
